GULFSTREAM IV





THE SPIRITUAL HOME OF MARTIAL ARTS






THE HAKKA MINORITY ROUND HOUSES

The novel, which also lends its name to the international hotel chain, was originally set in the destination of Zhongdian, in Yunnan province, at the border with Tibet. Commonly difficult to reach, China Elite is offering this stunning destination as an easy getaway, usually in combination with Lijiang or Xishuangbanna.

CHINA'S SOUTHERN BORDER




